Tellevate's standard audit process includes:

- Developing the scope and schedule of the audit
- Submitting a Pre-Visit Questionnaire (PVQ) to the audit location
- Collecting and reviewing PVQ information to prepare for the audit
- Customizing audit protocols to be used during the audit, including federal, state, permit, and local requirements
- Conducting audit entrance briefings for managers of audited operations
- On-site auditing to observe operations and determine compliance status
- Identifying root causes of findings
- Conducting audit exit briefings for managers
- Recommending corrective and preventive actions
- Reporting and data analysis

- A Bachelor's degree and no less than five years of experience. Senior auditors have at least fifteen years of auditing experience.
- Auditing certifications, such as the Board of EHS Auditor Certification (BEAC), Certified Professional Environmental Auditor (CPEA) or similar
- Training in the requirements of the ISO 14001/OHSAS 18001/ISO 45001 standards, including the BEAC Management Systems Auditor Certification
- Up-to-date subject matter and technical training
- Experience working as regulators in permitting and compliance assistance
